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PROCEDURAL STEPS

Here are some helpful procedural steps to assist you regarding your plans.

Ensure you can supply us with, and agree to the following:

- 1. Ensure you are allowed to build on the proposed site
- 2. Ensure you have the **finance available** as per our invoices
- 3. Have your **Site Identification** available (Council, Lot No. etc)
- 4. Ensure you have a valid **BAL Rating** (Bushfire Attack Level)
- 5. Make sure you have a Wind Rating (usually supplied by Council)
- 6. Supply a **Soil Test** (must be done by a certified approved person)
- 7. Supply an **Engineers** report for **foundations** (size of trenches etc)
- 8. Have a Site Survey done (include Contour Lines etc)
- 9. Fill in our 'Site Plan' and position your property as best you can
- 10. Ensure you have read and agree to our 'Purchase Agreement' as shown on the 'Forms' page of our website
- 11. Fill in and sign our 'Quote Form' and return to us with the specified deposit having been lodged by Direct Deposit to our Bank.

We will then organise the following:

- 1. Prepare Council Plans for submission by you to your Council or Building Surveyor
- 2. We will organise and pay for the required Certifications for Energy (Basix) and Frame and Truss reports
- 3. We will supply the necessary 'Site Identification' signs. On these Corflute signs will be your name, Owner Builder Permit Number, Contact Phone and Site Address etc
